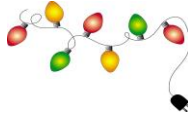

The Leeds and Thousand Islands Historical Society

LTI Historical Society was formed in 1992 by a group of local citizens who were concerned that our history was disappearing without being recorded. These included: William (Bill) Boulton, the late Shirley (Nunn) Fernetich, Alan Lindsay, Glenda Olivier, Bruce Kivle and Alexis Girling.

Historical Society Membership is \$15.00/yr (individual), \$30.00 (corporate) and includes 2 newsletters and voting rights. We hold 6 public meetings per year and support the LTI Archives financially and with time.

Potential programs for the spring include History of Area Masonic Lodges, the Brockville Car Industry, and Old Toys. Programs will be held the third Monday of March, May and June.

In the past two years, we have assisted with the research for the Schools of the Past Interpretive Sign, worked with LAFR to restore the Train Mural and are currently working on research for 2 more interpretive signs.
